A big win for gun owners

Windsor, Colo-National Association for Gun Rights (NAGR) members and supporters fueled pro-gun victories across the country, rejecting anti-gun politicians in Tuesday's election.

“The American people sent a clear message to politicians across the country that attacks on the Second Amendment will not be tolerated,” said Dudley Brown, President of the National Association for Gun Rights.

“The incoming Republican and Democratic politicians are on notice - nothing short of full protection of our Second Amendment rights will be accepted,” Brown said. “This election is a clear rebuke of President Obama and Michael Bloomberg’s radical anti-gun agenda. Gun owners must now begin the work of restoring our rights that were stolen over the years by anti-gun politicians.”

NAGR and NAGR-PAC were pivotal in this election, informing and mobilizing Second Amendment supporters across the country of candidates’ records on gun policy.

“With growing pro-gun majorities in Congress, we remain vigilant to ensure the incoming politicians honor their pledge to uphold the Second Amendment against any infringement,” says Brown.
