NAGR President holds press conference at Iowa's State Capitol

Des Moines, Iowa-Dudley Brown, President of the National Association for Gun Rights, held a press conference at Iowa's State Capitol on Wednesday to rally gun owners before the midterm election.

"The debate that is happening in Iowa is crucial in determining the course of gun legislation in the Senate," says Brown. "Iowa has the power to stop gun control czar Michael Bloomberg and Representative Bruce Braley's radical anti-gun agenda."

Gun owners and supporters in attendance were encouraged to show their solidarity for their Second Amendment rights and put politicians on notice, that if they vote for gun control, they will be held accountable.

"Congressman Bruce Braley voted against Iowans' gun rights this year, and he needs to hear from the tens of thousands of liberty-loving Iowans that voting against our gun rights is unacceptable," he says. "Tell Bruce Braley that his marching orders should come from Iowans and not from East Coast politicians and millionaires like Michael Bloomberg."

Brown held his press conference on the steps of the Iowa State Capitol on Wednesday, October 29th from 11:00 AM – 12:00PM.
